
Demographics

The Delaware district has almost 30,000 residents. The district has the lowest youth population of all the districts at 13.9%. Most Delaware district constituents identify as white (80%).⁶ Roughly one in every ten constituents identifies as black, and almost 7% identify as Hispanic.⁷

This district has the lowest unemployment of all districts at 3.5%. Just over one of every ten residents is disabled, the lowest rate among the districts.

Income⁸

The Delaware district is the wealthiest district in the City. Of all districts, it has the largest proportion of households making \$100,000 or more and the lowest proportion of households making less than \$20,000. Almost three quarters of households have an income above the city's median income (about \$35,000).





Poverty and Unaffordable Housing

Given what we know about district income, it is unsurprising that this district has the lowest poverty rate of all districts. However, over a third of renter households can't afford their housing costs (meaning that housing costs exceed 30% of the household's income). The same is true for about one in every five owner households. Almost 4,000 households (renters *and* owners) cannot afford their housing costs over a quarter (27.8%) of all Delaware district households.

Education¹³
